According to Their Way - Al Pi Darco Frequently Asked Questions

Where is your program located?

According to Their Way - Al Pi Darco (ATTW - APD) is located by the corner of 150th street and 72nd Ave. That is just three blocks from Young Israel of Kew Garden Hills on 150th street; or three blocks from Main the Chase bank on Main Street and 72nd Ave.

What are the hours?

Our program runs Monday to Thursday, from 8-4pm, and on Friday from 8-2:30 pm; when candle lighting on erev shabbos is before 5pm, dismissal is slightly earlier (November through January, approximately). We also offer extended hours, Monday through Thursday, from 4-4:30pm, for an additional fee. Extended hours are not offered on Fridays.

Does your calendar match up with any of the local yeshivos?

Our calendar is similar to that of the elementary yeshivos. We are closed for a few legal holidays. A full calendar will be distributed before the start of the school year.

Do you have a summer program?

No. We are open from September through June only.

How much is the tuition?

As According to Their Way - Al Pi Darco is a 3k, and therefore government subsidized, the tuition is greatly reduced. The tuition is \$3,000/year, or \$300/month.

Are there any additional costs?

In general, the only additional cost is a small fee to cover lice checks. There is a registration deposit of \$900, which is due at the time of enrollment; however, this deposit is included in the \$3,000 yearly tuition and covers tuition for September through November. So once the registration deposit is paid, you will only need to pay an additional \$2,100 for the school year.

What age children may be enrolled in your program?

Children looking to enroll in 3k must be three years old by December 31, 2025. In order to be eligible to enroll, your child must have been born in 2022.

Does my child need to be toilet trained before starting school?

No. If your child is toilet trained, wonderful, Baruch Hashem. If your child is still in diapers or just beginning to be toilet trained, that's fine as well. We will work with you and your child, starting from whatever level they are currently on.



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How many staff members are with the children throughout the day?

There can be a maximum of twelve students in the class. In general, Morah Yocheved and an assistant will always be with the students during the day (so there will be two staff members and twelve kids together at the same time). If, for whatever reason, there are only six students or less in school (for example, if some students have gone on vacation early prior to a scheduled closure, like a yom tov), then it's possible that only Morah Yocheved would be there on that day.

Are any snacks or meals provided by ATTW - APD?

Breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack are provided. All dairy products are cholov yisroel. We are a peanut-free school. Parents are asked to supply grape juice and fruit for the shabbos party, from the Shabbos Abba and Ima, respectively.

What does your program focus on or emphasize?

At According to Their Way- Al Pi Darco, we focus on the whole child, on all the different areas of development, using developmentally appropriate practices. The children learn via playing, singing songs, listening to stories, doing arts and crafts and having group discussions. Activities are designed to help children develop social-emotional, communication, and fine and gross motor skills, academic knowledge, middos tovos and a love for Hashem and yiddishkeit.
